Page 24, after line 20, insert the following (and re-designate subsequent provisions accordingly):

1 **SEC. 9. AUTHORIZATION OF THE INTELLIGENT TRANSPOR-**
2 **TATION SYSTEMS PROGRAM OFFICE.**

3 (a) **ESTABLISHMENT.**—There is established within
4 the Administration an Intelligent Transportation Systems
5 Program Office (in this section referred to as the “Of-
6 fice”).

7 (b) **OBJECTIVES.**—

8 (1) **IN GENERAL.**—The objective of the Office is
9 to carry out a program of research and to dem-
10 onstrate, test, and facilitate the deployment of tech-
11 nology to enhance the safety, efficiency, convenience,
12 and environmental sustainability of surface transpor-
13 tation systems.

14 (2) **IMPLEMENTATION.**—The objective shall be
15 carried out through research and development, oper-
16 ational testing, technology transfer, training, and
17 technical guidance.

18 (3) **APPROPRIATENESS.**—The Administrator
19 shall ensure that all intelligent transportation sys-

1 tems research contains a component of social science
2 and human factors research to ensure that such in-
3 telligent transportation systems research is appro-
4 priate to the needs of the communities, States, or
5 other intended users to which the technologies will
6 deploy.

7 (c) PERFORMANCE MEASURES.—Not later than 6
8 months after the date of enactment of this Act, the Ad-
9 ministrator shall establish performance metrics to evaluate
10 all Department-funded intelligent transportation system
11 deployments.

12 (d) GAO STUDY.—The Comptroller General of the
13 United States shall complete a biannual study assessing
14 the deployment of intelligent transportation systems
15 projects in meeting the performance metrics established
16 under subsection (c).
